The program consists of 4 modules.

1. My Profile (baseline), 2. Company Visit, 2. My Talents and finally 4. Career Interview and not to forget, the eLibrary

4 Modules

- My Profile children complete the questionnaire in this module, providing us with personal information, hobbies and interests as well as 3 jobs they think they would like to have in the future. (Baseline study)
- Company Visit in groups children explore the eLibrary, select a company
 they would like to visit, prepare questions to ask, practice interviewing skills, visit
 the company and make a presentation for their peers who visited another
 company.
- My Talents Children select character traits they think they have, ask parents and friends to indicate what they are good at and do quizzes to learn more about their talents.
- Career Interview children select form the eLibrary a professional they would like to interview. They prepare questions to ask and learn to be alert to compare talents of the professional with their own.
